November 26, 2017 – Richmond, Virginia - The Richmond Symphony Chorus will audition prospective new members at Epiphany Lutheran Church from 6:30pm to 9:30pm on Tuesday evening, December 12. If you are interested in auditioning, you will be asked to complete and submit a short audition questionnaire and schedule an appointment.

The Chorus rehearses weekly on Tuesday evenings from late August through early May at the Dominion Arts Center. Additional rehearsals take place during performance weeks.

During the 2017-18 season, the Chorus joined the Richmond Symphony Orchestra in performances of Mozart's Mass in C-minor and will participate in a world premiere by Mason Bates, in addition to its annual performances of Handel's Messiah and the "Let It Snow" Christmas Pops programs. In February, Chorus members will participate in concerts honoring Martin Luther King, "Remembering 1968: A Tribute to MLK."
