# Richmond Symphony Welcomes Second Music Director Candidate, Ankush Kumar Bahl

Richmond, Va. (Dec. 19, 2019)—The Richmond Symphony kicks off 2020 by hosting its second **Music Director Candidate**, **Ankush Kumar Bahl**. The Indian-American conductor will lead a number of Symphony concerts and pre-concert talks in the community, including:

- <u>Altria Masterworks</u> concert on **Sat., Jan. 11 at 8 p.m.** at Dominion Energy Center, Carpenter Theatre, with Anthony McGill, clarinet; pre-concert talk with Bahl at **7 p.m.**
- <u>Community concert</u> on **Sun., Jan. 12 at 3 p.m.** at Mount Vernon Baptist Church in Glen Allen with Anthony McGill, clarinet
- Pops: Journey into the Cosmos concert on Sat., Jan. 18 at 8 p.m. at Dominion Energy Center, Carpenter Theatre

Bahl is a protégé of former New York Philharmonic Music Director Kurt Masur and served as his assistant conductor of the Orchestre National de France, the Royal Concertgebouw Orchestra, and the Leipzig Gewandhaus Orchestra. He has also served as assistant conductor of the National Symphony Orchestra under Christoph Eschenbach and has guest-conducted some of the world's most prestigious orchestras and festivals, including most recently the New York Philharmonic.

Bahl is the second of five music director candidates leading the Symphony in the 2019-20 season and auditioning to follow former Music Director Steven Smith, who stepped down from the position at the end of last season. The other candidates are Laura Jackson, Valentina Peleggi, Farkhad Khudyev, and Roderick Cox, who led the Symphony in multiple concerts last October.

The Richmond Symphony search committee, comprised of symphony musicians and board members, received more than 200 applications before selecting the final five candidates. The committee is considering various criteria for each candidate, including musicianship and commitment to the community, but mutual chemistry between the audience and the orchestra will be paramount, according to David Fisk, executive director of the Richmond Symphony. The announcement of the new music director is expected in May 2020.
